

So You Think You Got A Shoal: AISAP - Exercise 2 – Add AIS Data to a Project

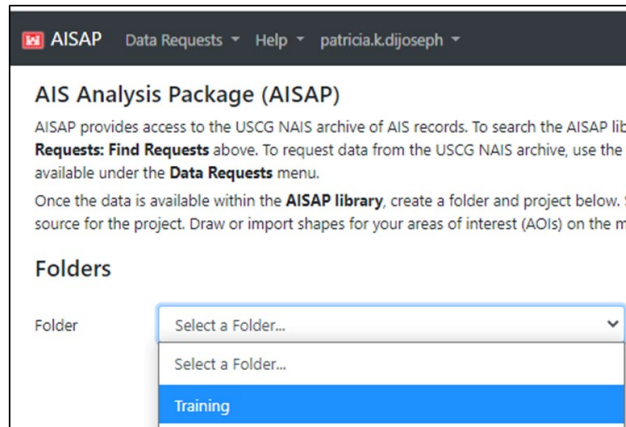
Before Starting: • You need an AISAP account with a username and password.

• You need to complete Exercise 1.

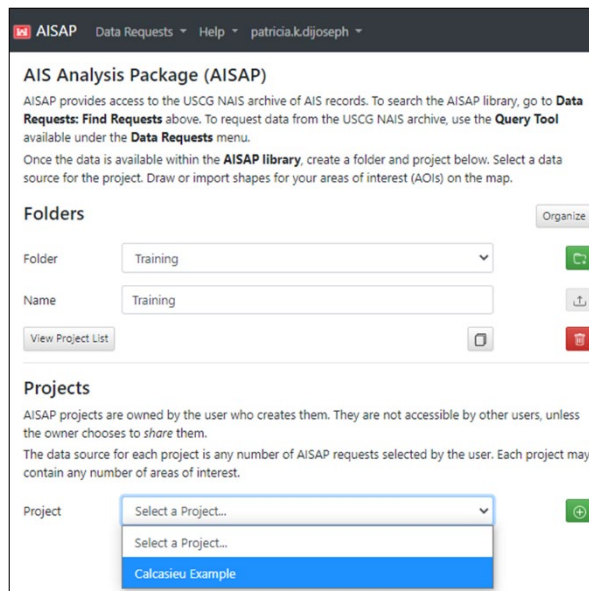
Exercise Goal: Learn how to search the AISAP library for AIS data and add AIS data to a project.

Add Data to your Project from the AISAP library

1. Log in to AISAP-Cloud https://aisap.usacegis.us/aisap_portal/home.html
2. Choose the **Folder** “Training” from the **Folder** dropdown menu that you created in Exercise 1.



3. Choose the **Project** “Calcasieu Example” from the **Project** dropdown menu that you created in Exercise 1.



4. Click on the **orange Edit/Pencil** icon that is to the right of **Source**.

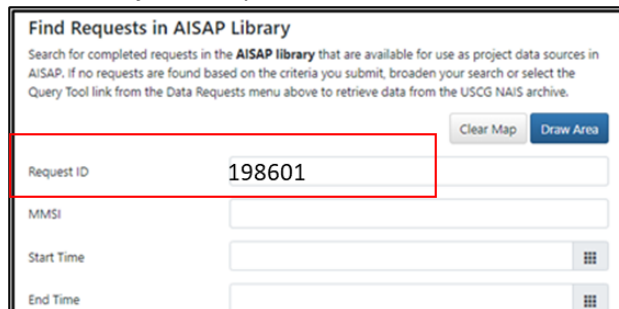

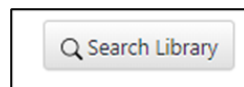
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5. In the **Request ID** field, type in **198601**

This request ID is associated with AIS data for the Calcasieu area for the week of May 1-5, 2019. For projects where you don't know your request ID, you can search for requests using the different search fields including "Draw Area" and "Start Time", for example.

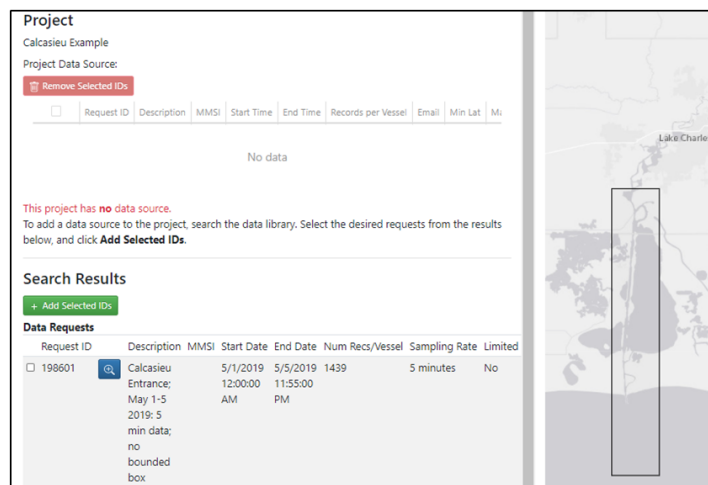


6. Click the **Search Library** button.



Your screen will update, now the map will have a box around the request area.

7. Scroll down on the left side of the screen to see the list of requests returned. For this example, there should be only one result, which matches the Request ID you asked AISAP to retrieve.

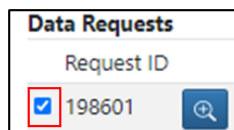

8. Check the **box** next to Request ID 198601.



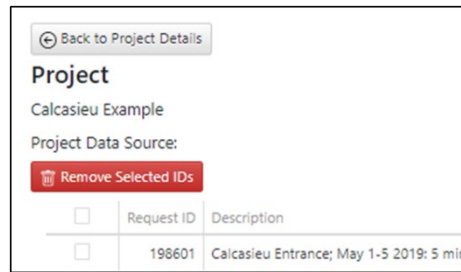
9. Next, click the green **Add Selected IDs** button.



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10. Under the **Project** section, find the **Project Data Source**. Check that the number next to it is the Request ID you just added.

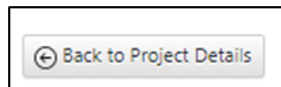
You can add multiple data sources to your project.

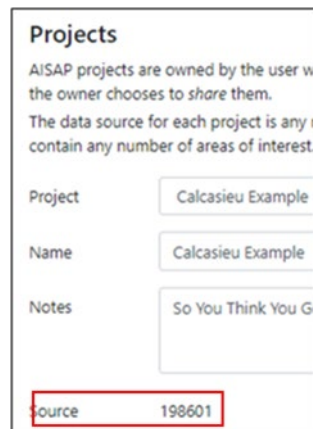
11. Last, click the button **Back to Project Details**.
